



Frequently Asked Questions 2012 Just4Kids Motor Trail

Come, Drive with Us!!

THE RED CENTRE ADVENTURE GOONDIWINDI TO BOULIA 6 – 24 SEPTEMBER 2012 (as at November 2011)

WHAT IS MY INVESTMENT, WHAT DO I NEED TO DO, HOW DO I DO IT?

- \$950 non-refundable entry fee per vehicle (entry forms are available on our website at www.just4kidsmotortrail.com.au) includes cost for Uluru Park Pass and NPA Road permits. Total - \$950 payable on registration. **Now revised to \$250 payable on registration to secure your place and the balance payable prior to 30th June 2012.**
- \$750.00 tax deductible donation per person (adult 17 yrs and over) **(now reduced to \$500 per person)** travelling in the entered vehicle. 3 or more adults travelling in same vehicle, maximum donation payable \$2,250.
- Accommodation will be varied for the Red Centre Adventure. Just4Kids will reserve rooms and camp sites that will be payable by entrants. You will need to confirm your booking direct from the J4K accommodation list supplied at the time of registration. Shared camping and accommodation will also be available with other J4K entrants and there will be occasions on the Red Centre trip that camping is the only option. The accommodation list will be provided on receipt of your registration and payment of the \$250 deposit.
- *\$1150.00 per adult for all meals, some tours, and functions for eighteen days including the "Sounds of Silence" dinner at Uluru and final night dinner function at Boulia.
Children – 0-4 years meals, events, functions – Free Of Charge
5-12 years - \$650 per head (if travelling with family)
13-16 years - \$875 per head (if travelling with family)
17 and over – full adult price (\$1150.00 per head)
A rate for families of 2 Adults + 3 children or more will be considered on an individual basis. Please apply if this is your group.

- Some tours will be included in pre paid meal/tour/entry fee and payable by Just4Kids. An optional extras list will be made available to assist with lay day choices – these are payable by the individual entrant.
- **Please Note:** There will be “**OPTIONAL EXTRA**” TOURS available at some locations, including Marree, Coober Pedy, Ayers Rock and Alice Springs. Any **OPTIONAL EXTRAS** mentioned in correspondence means payment for these **OPTIONAL EXTRA TOURS OR ACTIVITIES** is payable by the individual entrants and **not** covered in your Just4Kids entry or meals/tours component of the event.
- All vehicle costs including fuel for the vehicle is payable by individual entrant.

What is the tax-deductible donation used for?

This money is presented to the disabled, sick and disadvantaged children or their respective organisations along the Just4Kids Motor Trail. We also make donations to the various schools we visit to help with any special projects they may be involved with.

Additional funds are distributed throughout the year to Just4Kids projects and through the Just4Kids Youth Support Program

Can my entry and other associated costs be sponsored by an organisation?

Yes, you can obtain sponsorship for your entry and costs if you wish, the majority of entrants do. The *\$750 (now \$500) donation per person is 100% tax deductible. Details about Just4Kids and their charity status and registration forms are available on the website.

Do I need a four wheel drive?

The route is suitable for 4x4, AWDs and well set up 2WD vehicles. Please obtain a copy of the “TJM recommended compulsory and suggested items” for your trip, by downloading the list from our TJM N.T. vehicle requirements link. All vehicles will be scrutinised prior to the Event’s departure date and will need to pass this requirement before starting the Motor Trail.

Please check with the Motor Trail Director, Mark Louez, well in advance about the circuit conditions Ph: 0747 59 1450 or 0429 090 199. Keep in mind that conditions may vary from the official survey date. For any person wanting to do a 4x4 driving course prior to our 2012 Event, please contact Dave Darmody, P7, through our website. Dave is a licensed off road driving instructor and is familiar with our requirements.

Can entrants dress in a theme, as well as decorate their vehicle?

Yes, as we will be visiting schools and large groups of children, a theme for your entry is encouraged and POINTS are awarded for the most innovative themes.

Do I have to provide my own meals and arrange accommodation along the way?

No, this is all organised by the volunteer committee and all meals are part of your entry costs (please see above).

If you have special dietary needs arrangements will be put in place to manage your requirements. You will receive a form for this on registration which must be filled out and all personal information is held in a sealed envelope by our medic.

All you will need to do is just relax, have fun and enjoy the day in the country. There will be occasions where you will pre make your lunch from our mobile kitchen (all food is supplied).

This is due to distances and the resources available on the selected route for that period only. Details will be provided on our day running sheet.

Your accommodation will be pre organised and a list sent to you upon receipt of your entry form and the \$950 car entry (**now on receipt of your \$250 deposit on your entry fee**). It is up to the individual entrants to book and pay for their own accommodation using this list.

Can I tow a Camper trailer or use a Campervan

You can travel with an off road 4x4 campervan, such as a Britz Troupe carrier or swag down with a Sargent 4x4 Troupe carrier or tow a camper trailer if you wish to reduce motel costs. The Northern Territory is well set up for campers. Keep in mind that the roads can be corrugated and trailers will need to be in good condition and some spares should be carried. All overnight stops have camping grounds and the majority have caravan parks. If road conditions change for trailers, the Motor Trail Director will advise well in advance as Just4Kids has a scout team to check conditions each day. If an alternate route is required for that section, those people involved will rejoin the circuit, with an official, when it is practical to do so.

Will there be mobile phone coverage in the towns we are visiting?

Your digital phone will be limited in its coverage in remote areas during this event.

The Telstra Next G during the survey had coverage in some areas. Telstra pay phones are available. A phone card and coins are recommended.

Just4Kids Satellite Phone 24/7 numbers to receive or send a message will be issued at a later date.

A list of all overnight stops, with the address and phone number of the Motels and Caravan/camping Parks will be provided.

Officials will have satellite phones if you need to make an emergency call from a remote area.

Is there support if my vehicle breaks down?

Yes, there are service crews to assist you if you break down.

Driving to the conditions of the road with lower speeds and good tyres with a vehicle that is not overloaded makes for a trouble free event.

Some spare parts should be carried for emergencies.

Can Just4Kids assist me with my fundraising?

Just4Kids has a variety of concepts to help you raise funds.

Does Just4Kids have members that I can network with?

When do I have to get my entry registration and associated payments in by?

An expression of interest is desirable ASAP as numbers will be limited. We suggest you pay your car entry of \$950 as a deposit (**now acceptable to pay and initial deposit of \$250 with the balance later**) to secure your position and finalise your total payment by 30th June 2012 to obtain the tax benefit.

Numbers are limited for 2012 due to special locations, EPA restrictions and logistics for catering. PLEASE book NOW to avoid disappointment!

Can I make split Payments?

YES, Just4Kids can bill you Monthly or you can pay via Credit Card.

The car entry of \$950 (now a deposit of \$250 with the balance paid in full prior to the receipt of further invoices) is required to reserve your place and your preferred vehicle number. As soon as the \$950 is received we will issue the accommodation list. To take advantage of the 2011/12 tax period we suggest you pay the per person donation in full by 30th of June 2012. The per person entry donation fee being *\$750 (now reduced to \$500 per person) is 100% claimable as a Charity donation.

How many other cars will be participating in Just4Kids Great Australian Motor Trail?

The 2012 Just4Kids Motor Trail is set at around 30 units plus official vehicles.
