

Generous Ben chooses to give local charity his birthday presents!

Year Four student **Ben Henderson** doesn't want an ipad or the latest Xbox game for his ninth birthday this month. He wants to enhance the lives of local people with spinal cord injuries by forgoing birthday presents this year and asking family and friends to donate to the Spinal Injuries Association at Cranbrook. Ben decided to go without gifts this year after hearing his dad, Darryl Henderson, speak about his involvement with the Association's North Queensland Supporters Committee.

"My dad knows a lot of the people that they (the Association) helps and he tells us about how expensive it is when you use a wheelchair," Ben said. "I want to raise money for people to help them with buying equipment like wheelchairs." In just a few weeks, Ben's generous gesture has already raised an impressive \$2,000 for the Spinal Injuries Association.

Darby Case was born just before Christmas 2008. She arrived quickly and proceeded to turn her parents world upside down when she was diagnosed with Rubinstein Taybi Syndrome (RTS) on day 2 and flown off to the Royal Children's Hospital in Brisbane.

Darby was found to have a number of major medical conditions including holes in her heart, silent aspiration of liquids into her lungs, obstructive and obstructive sleep apnoea, low muscle tone, reflux, constipation, hyper flexible joints, and a low lying spinal cord. She was nil by mouth until 15 months old when she started eating puree but she still requires her fluids by feeding tube.

Due to her medical and feeding issues, Darby's development is very delayed. At the age of 23 months Darby's parents found out about the Australian Institute for the Achievement of Human Potential and started two and a half hours of daily therapy with Darby with the assistance of some wonderful volunteers. Darby's therapy includes a lot of cross patterning and sensory and stimulation exercises which have taken Darby from minimal movement before starting, to crawling around everywhere and pulling herself to stand at 30months.

It has been fantastic for Darby and her parents to see such great progress and they are extremely thankful for the Just for Kids Charity. Medical and therapy costs for Darby are high and Just for Kids have made it easy for Darby to continue working with the Institute by funding this essential therapy which is helping Darby achieve her potential.
